

Hill Road Bollard cover pattern (to be ready by 12/4/21)

Knitted in the round version.

Materials - 200g chunky yarn, or use 2 strands DK together, & use up all your oddments!

- 1 set of 4 6mm spns.

Cast on 64 stitches, arrange over 3 needles, join into the round + work with fourth needle as follows (use a marker to indicate beginning of rounds if you like).

Work 4 rounds K2P2 rib, then proceed with every round knit, until work measures 20cm.

Next round: [K2 tog, K14] 4 times.

Continue in knit until work measures 40cm

Next round: [K2 tog, K13] 4 times.

Continue working rounds, decreasing 4 stitches every 20cm until you have 48 stitches remaining (4 decrease rounds in total)

Continue knitting until your bollard cover measures 95cm long. Now decrease for the top:-

Next round: [K4 K2 tog] 8 times

Next round Knit

Next round [K~~4~~3 K2 tog] 8 times

Next round Knit

Next round [K2 K2 tog] 8 times

Next round Knit

Next round [K1 K2 tog] 8 times

Next round Knit

Next round K2 tog 8 times

Break yarn, thread end through remaining stitches, fasten off securely. Job done!!
